

## Letter to the Churches

The world is running amok. There are HUGE structural problems in the world's economical, financial, political, business, and religious systems. It is understandable that our government has tremendous difficulties in their attempts at solving these problems. It appears that all attempts to solve these challenges are getting America and Hawaii deeper in the HOLE.

We, the body of Christ recognize that the solutions to the problems of the world will not be found in the government or in business. It will not be just a matter of an improving business climate, the solving of government, business and personal debt that deal with these issues. We recognize that "in Him was life, and that life was the light of men." It is now time to live that belief and we at "EACH1 REACH1" are calling the body of Christ to have each person reach one person in the church and one person within your families. The strong in Christ can surely expand that call to outside the body.

The bible tells us: "...If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land." (2 Chron 7:14) Our land desperately needs healing and based on this passage, we believe that God has called HIS people to live ALL of these things: humble themselves, AND pray, AND seek Him, AND turn from their wicked ways. These are the 3 most important ANDs for God's people to live in order to participate with God in His Healing of the Land.

We believe that God has a predetermined time for the "HEALING OF THE LAND" and that time is coming soon. God does not need His body to do all these things, in order for HIM to respond and HEAL THE LAND. We believe that as GOD starts HIS healing of the lands (and the starting gun may have already sounded), the body of Christ who please HIM by living all of these things, will GET to participate in the HEALING OF THE LAND. It will be an honor for us to participate.

While we do not know exactly what that means for each one of you, we do believe that one aspect of our focus needs to be within the church as the body of Christ. The church has (rightly so) focused much of its efforts on reaching outside its walls. We believe there needs to be a greater focus within our walls. We believe our churches are filled with hurting people with HUGE needs, and they need someone within the body to reach out to them, come along side and minister/mentor them, their kids, and their families.

The model is in Acts 2: Acts 2:42-47. "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. 45 Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

This is not a condemnation of the church or the body of Christ, but in general the church is not living this today. The early church "believers were together and had everything in common..." They were meeting together every day... eating together, fellowshiping together with glad and sincere hearts. They met each others needs: spiritual,(emotional), relational, motivational, and material (Ed Silviso, Transformation). This is taking place in a very small per cent of the body today. While some may say that it is impossible for "all" the body to be meeting together, meeting all their needs, we would say "nothing is impossible with God."

So we are casting a small mission for the body of Christ to participate in this grass roots program. This is available to all who hears the Voice of God: "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land."

While it is not possible for one person to reach all, or one church to reach all, or one group to reach all, we believe that if EACH1 would REACH1, we would be on our way to having God meet the needs of all people. More importantly, GOD would be smiling and would count us as participants in His healing of the land.
